- Sequoyah invented the Cherokee alphabet.

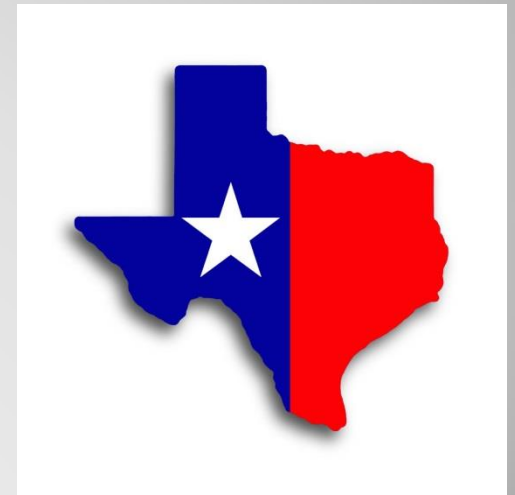

- He helped to found the city of Nashville.

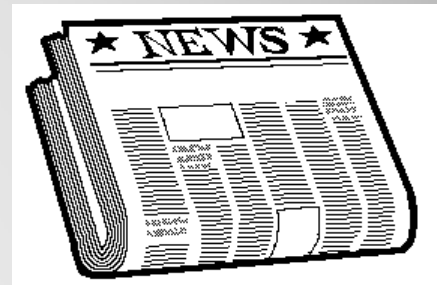
