Summary of the video/play **This is a film about the women's suffrage movement of the early 1900s. It shows the struggles, hardship, and resistance faced by women activists such as Alice Paul and Lucy Burns.**

Importance to the curriculum/unit of study **This film does a wonderful job of showing how difficult it was for women to gain voting rights. It illustrates the struggles between women on the issue, the complexity of race in the movement, the strong opposition to it and the harsh treatment of activists, as well as places the movement in the historical context of the WWI era. We will be watching this as a part of a unit on the Progressive Era, and the students will complete a short essay assignment over the film.**

This video/play has a/an **TV-14** rating and some may find it objectionable because of **extremely brief nudity in a jail scene. This film does not have an MPAA rating because it was made by HBO. It does not use explicit language and while I omit one particular scene when we view this at school, if viewed at home your child will likely see it. It is sexual in nature but not graphic. If you would like to omit this for your child it hits right about the 43 minute mark and lasts approximately a minute or two. I think the film was made in very good taste and I encourage you to preview it if you have any questions about your son or daughter watching the film for class.
