NEWS ITEMS FROM THE KNOXVILLE ENQUIRER

5 March 1828

The Steam-Boat *Atlas*, Capt S. D. Conner, arrived at our town yesterday morning. This is the first Steam-Boat that has ever ventured up the Holston.

29 October 1828

Capt Conner and Company have just arrived at this place, as we understand, to establish a Boat-Yard for the purpose of building Steam-Boats to ply the River. This is the enterprising gentleman who ascended to this place and above last winter with the Steam-Boat *Atlas*.
